- We also recommend always having some cash on you, while please note that American Express is not accepted everywhere (Visa and MasterCard are).
- Greece is extremely safe, but this does not mean we don't have our fair share of pickpockets who have an eye for tourists. We don't recommend keeping your phone or wallet in your back pocket.

A few Greek words:

- Kalimera (pronounced kal - ee - mer - ah), meaning "good morning"
- Kalinihta (pronounced kal - ee - nee - hta), meaning "good night"
- Efharisto (pronounced ef - har - ees - to), meaning "thank you"
- Yia Mas (pronounced yia - mas), meaning "cheers"!
